Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Lahore to Islamabad

- Drive from Lahore to Islamabad. Visit Faisal Mosque, Pakistan Monument, and Lok Virsa Museum.
- Overnight stay in Islamabad.

Day 2 : Islamabad to Burawai

- Depart early for Burawai via road. Arrive and check into your hotel.
- Relax and explore Burawai. Overnight in Burawai.

Day 3 : Burawai to Skardu

- Depart early for Skardu via road. Arrive and check into your hotel.
- Relax and enjoy your stay at the hotel at Skardu. Overnight in Skardu.

Day 4 : Exploring Skardu

- Visit Shangrila Resort, Upper Kachura Lake, and Shigar Valley.
- Enjoy local scenery and hospitality. Overnight in Skardu.

Day 5 : Skardu to Khaplu

- Travel to Khaplu Valley, visit the grand Khaplu Fort, and explore the town's local markets.
- Overnight in Khaplu.

Day 6 : Khaplu to Shigar

- Return to Shigar. Tour Shigar Fort, now a heritage hotel.
- Interact with the Balti community and enjoy the valley's peaceful ambiance. Overnight in Shigar.

Day 7 : Shigar to Hunza

- Journey toward Hunza, stopping at the Junction Point of three mountain ranges.
- Arrive in Karimabad, check in, and unwind. Overnight in Hunza.

Day 8 : Exploration of Hunza

Visit Baltit Fort and Altit Fort, stroll through Karimabad Bazaar, and take in orchard-covered hills. Overnight in Karimabad.

Day 9 : Upper Hunza & Khunjerab Pass

Day trip to Khunjerab Pass, passing Ganesh Village, Borith Lake, Attabad Lake, and crossing the thrilling Hussaini Suspension Bridge. Overnight in Hunza.

Day 10 : Hunza to Gilgit

Drive to Gilgit, visit Kargah Buddha, and explore the Gilgit Bazaar. Enjoy a local dinner. Overnight in Gilgit.

Day 11 : Naltar Valley Excursion

- Take a scenic day trip to Naltar Valley—famous for its colorful lakes and skiing spots.
- Return to Gilgit for the night.

Day 12 : Gilgit to Lahore

Depart from Gilgit to Islamabad, then drive back to Lahore, concluding your northern adventure.
