

Rakaposhi & Diran Base Camp Trekking Adventure

Embark on a 4-day trekking adventure that takes you through some of the most awe-inspiring landscapes of the Karakoram. Starting from the serene village of Minapin in Nagar Valley, this trek offers a perfect blend of accessibility and raw alpine beauty — making it one of the most rewarding short treks in northern Pakistan.

Journey through green meadows and alpine forests as you hike to the base camps of two iconic peaks: Rakaposhi (7,788m) and Diran (7,266m). The adventure doesn't end there — cross glacial paths and ascend to the hidden alpine gem, Kacheli Lake (3,870m), a turquoise lake few travelers ever witness. Perfect for adventure seekers and nature lovers alike, this guided trek is an unforgettable way to experience Hunza and Nagar's natural wonders, cultural richness, and high-altitude magic — all within four action-packed days.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Minapin Village → Hapakun (2,800m)

Begin your adventure from the peaceful Minapin village. The trail winds through lush meadows and alpine forests, gradually gaining elevation. After 4-5 hours of trekking, you'll arrive at **Hapakun (2,800m)** where your first night will be spent camping amidst nature.

Day 2 : Hapakun → Rakaposhi Base Camp (Tagaphari) (3-4 hours trek)

Today's journey leads to **Tagaphari (3,500m)** — the base camp of Rakaposhi. Enjoy breathtaking views of Rakaposhi and Diran Peak as you traverse open grasslands and glacial terrain. Camp overnight with the giants of the Karakoram as your backdrop.

Day 3 : Rakaposhi Base Camp → Diran Base Camp → Kacheli Lake (3,870m)

Descend briefly to reach **Diran Base Camp**, crossing icy paths and glacial crossings. From there, continue your ascent to the breathtaking **Kacheli Lake (3,870m)**, a pristine turquoise lake tucked away from the usual trekking routes. Set up camp by the lake and unwind under the stars.

Day 4 : Kacheli to Khuwat(Miachar) (7 to 8 hours down)

Descend through alpine forests and rugged trails toward **Khuwat viewpoint (3,300m)**. Enjoy expansive views of the Rakaposhi glacier one last time before hopping onto a jeep for your return journey to **Hunza Karimabad**.
